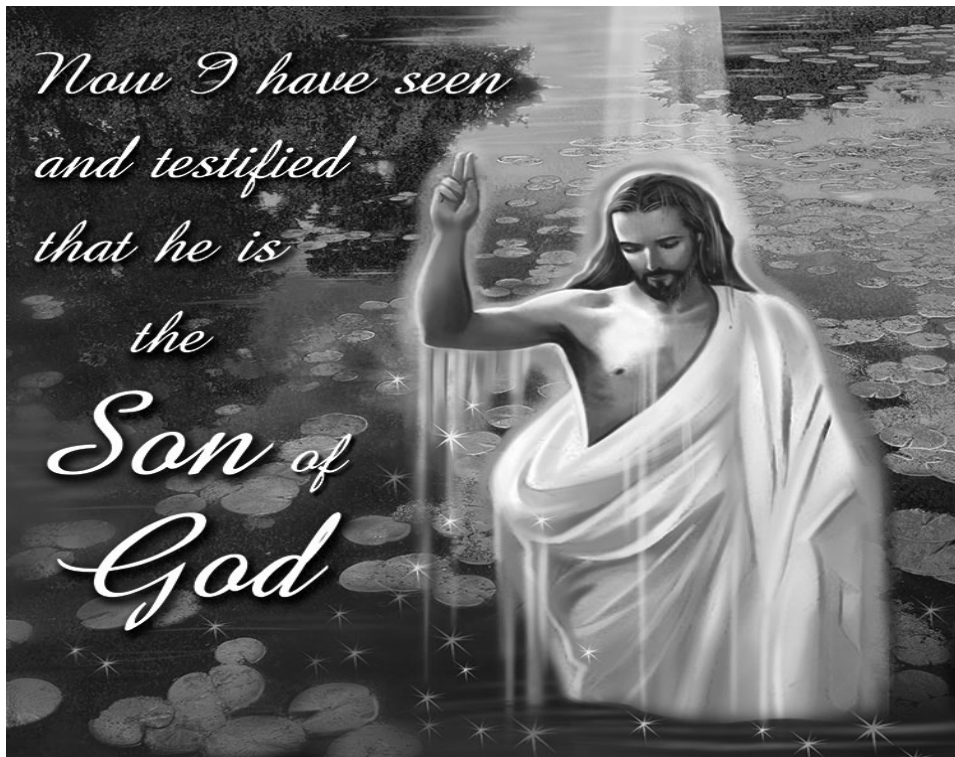

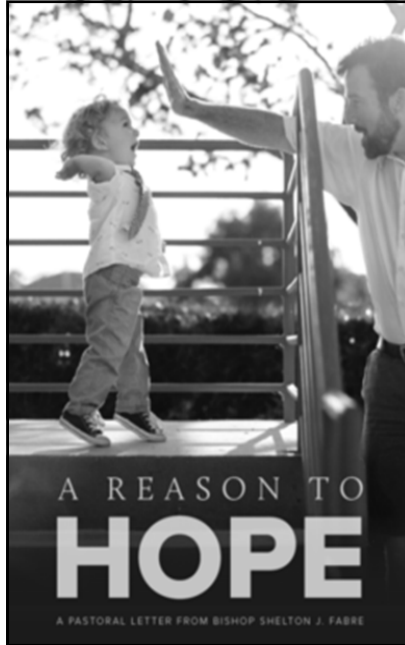


**Psalm** — Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will (Psalm 40).
