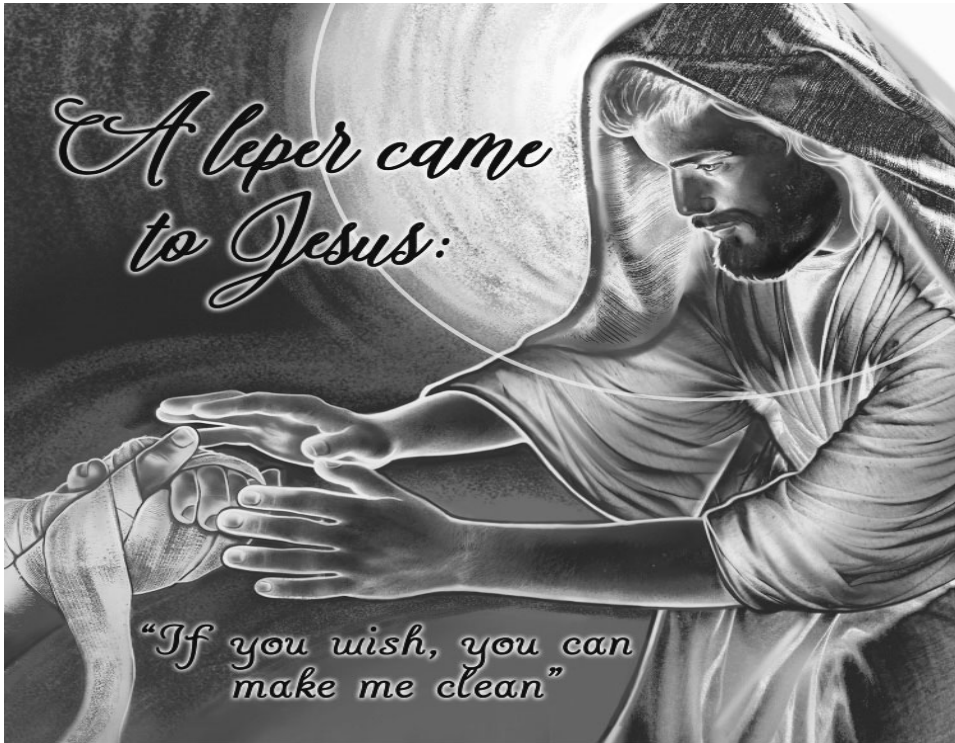

Sunday, February 11th, the World Day of the Sick is observed. In conjunction with this day and with the Gospel messages of Jesus beginning his healing ministry, Fr. Freddie & Fr. Noas will offer the Sacrament of the



Anointing of the Sick to those who wish to receive the anointing. The Sacrament of Anointing will be administered **following all Masses**

on the weekend of February 10th & 11th. The gravely and chronically ill and the elderly are encouraged to receive this Sacrament.



Ashes will be distributed during the 6:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Masses on Ash Wednesday. Ashes **only** will be distributed at 12:10 Noon, no Mass.

Following Ash Wednesday, daily Mass will be offered at 6:30 a.m. and 12:10 Noon, Monday thru Friday. Each Saturday, as well as First Saturday, Mass will be celebrated at 8:30 a.m.

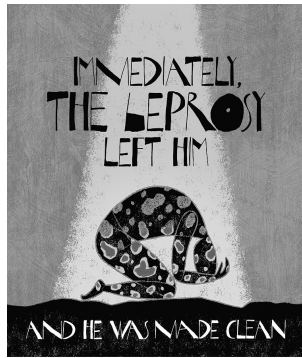
WEEKEND READINGS
