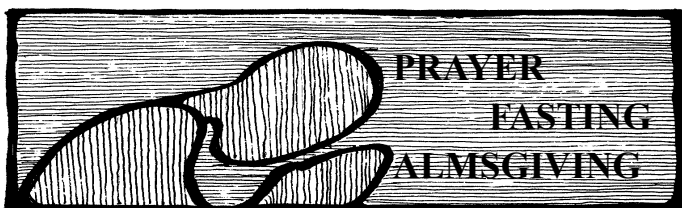

**LENTEN REGULATIONS REGARDING
FAST AND ABSTINENCE**

The Church defines fasting as eating one full meal a day, and two smaller meals, which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. To abstain means that a person should not eat meat on the days of abstinence. Thus, the rules for fasting and abstinence in the United States are:

***Every person** 14 years of age or older **must abstain** from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

***Every person** between the age of 18 and 59 (your 59th birthday begins your 60th year) **must fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Stations will be prayed **each Friday in Lent at 6:30 p.m.**, followed by a Lenten supper in the cafeteria for those attending stations.



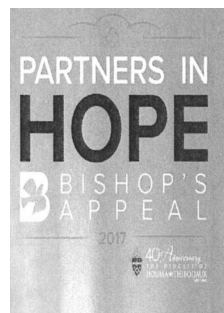
**SUNDAY, MARCH 5TH

WEEKEND READINGS

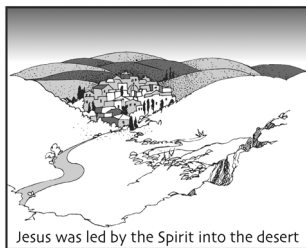
First Reading — The man and the woman ate the fruit of the one tree that God had told them to avoid, and their shame overtook them (Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7).
