# LENTEN REGULATIONS

The Church defines fasting as eating one full meal a day, and two smaller meals, which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. To abstain means that a person should not eat meat on the days of abstinence. Thus, the rules for fasting and abstinence in the United States are:

\*Every person 14 years of age or older **must abstain** from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

\*Every person between the age of 18 and 59 (your 59th birthday begins your 60th year) must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.





Daylight Savings Time begins next Sunday, March 10th at 2:00 A.M. It is suggested that we set our clocks **FORWARD** one hour before going to bed.
