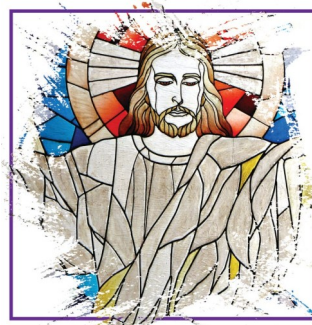
2nd Reading Question: Paul taught that reconciliation with God and with each other was key to being a “new creation.” How often do you experience reconciliation with God or with others?

Father, to be cared for. But his Father surprises him with his mercy, as God surprises us. He offers more than just forgiveness. He offers redemption.

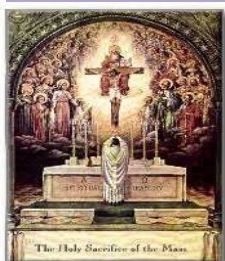
