**WEDDINGS:** Couples should make an appointment with the parish priest at least six months in advance.

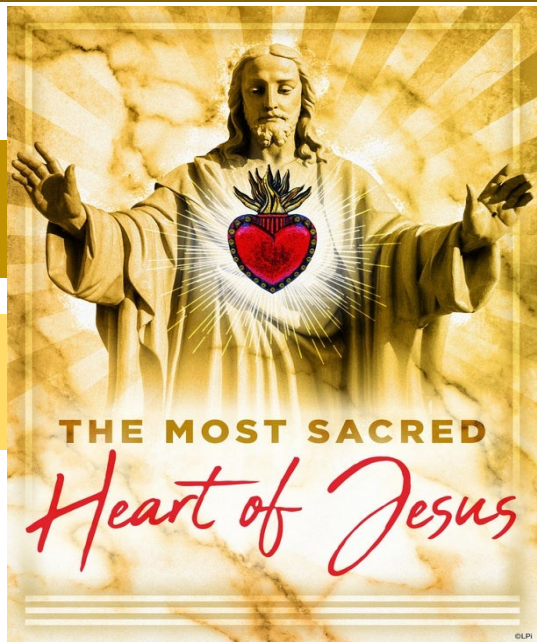
