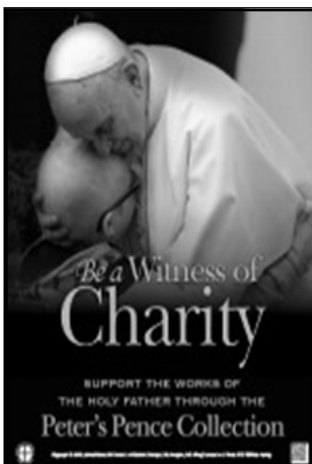
HELP NEEDED !!!

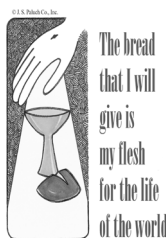
WEEKEND READINGS
