Nativity of St. John the Baptist

Since June 24 falls on a Sunday this year, the Church has the opportunity for a more intense celebration of the birth of John the Baptist, who is often described as the last of the Old Testament prophets and the bridge between Judaism and Christianity. More commonly, John is known as the "precursor" of our Lord Jesus Christ. All the Gospels report John's basic message: Repent, the kingdom is near at hand.

One greater than I is coming.

Though he was a wandering preacher who dressed in camel skins and ate grasshoppers, John's legacy is one of true royalty. His origins are similar to those foretold by God through the prophet Isaiah: "You are my servant, he said to me, Israel through whom I show my glory" (Isaiah 49:3). John's humility—"I am not he"—was surpassed only by that of his Lord Jesus, the humble servant who followed.

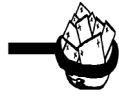

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

This is a special announcement for our parishioners as we prepare for hurricane season. At the Matthew 25 meeting we were advised that preparations have been made for those persons who will need transportation out of Morgan City when an evacuation order has been issued.

Persons fitting this description need to call St. Mary Parish Office of Homeland Security and to register with them. This will assure you a place on their list of persons needing help.

If you know of anyone that needs to be aware of this help, a neighbor, a relative, a friend, please inform them and/or help them to register.

If you know of an elderly person, especially those who are more or less homebound, ask them if they have a plan for an emergency and/or a disaster. Ask if they have someone who will take care of them before, during and after a hurricane? Give them one of the hurricane preparedness booklets given out by homeland security and encourage them to plan
