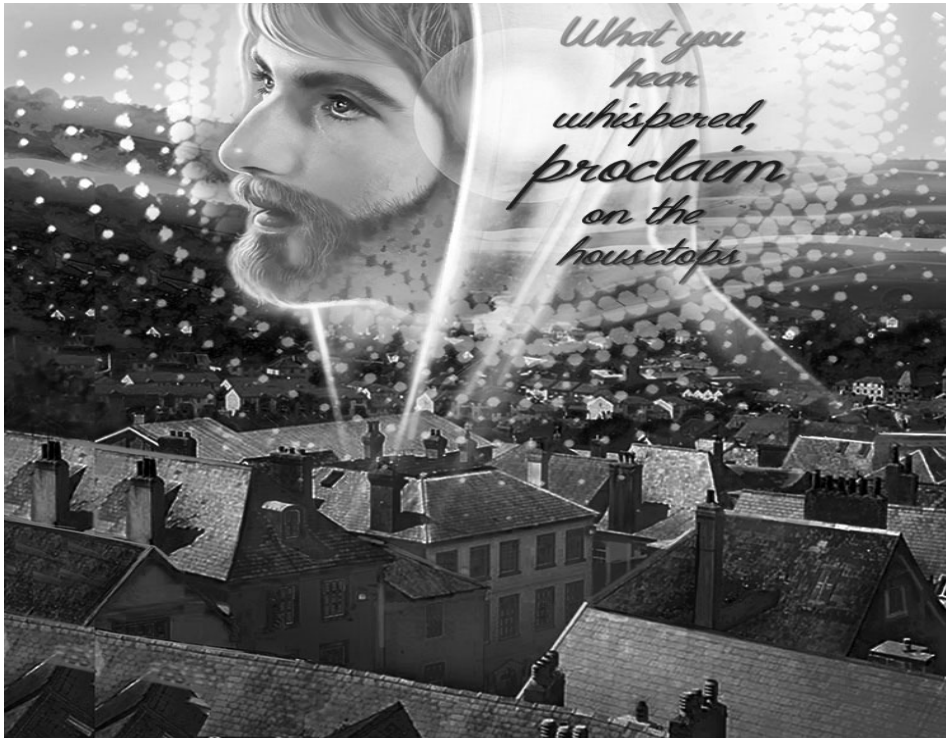

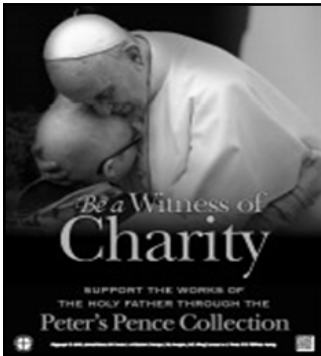
### **FATHER FREDDIE OUT OF PARISH**

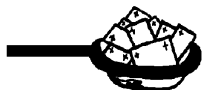
