100th Year Anniversary of Sacred Heart Church's Dedication Day

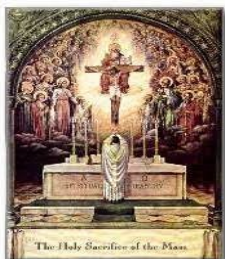

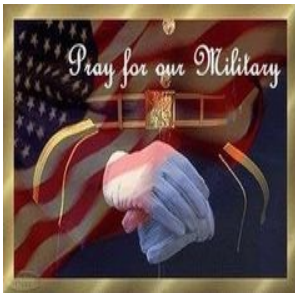

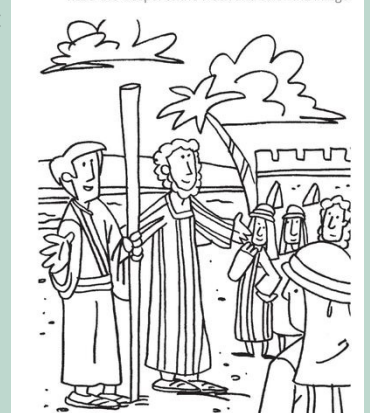
