

Jesus, help me to be brave. I know you can do anything.



# Mass at a Glance

# **Part 1: Preparation**

Any good cook knows that before cooking anything in a frying pan, you have to heat the pan with oil of some kind so the pan is ready to cook. In a similar way, if we are to be ready to receive deeply from God the graces He offers us in the Holy Mass, we have to prepare our own souls to receive them. The disposition, or state of openness, of our hearts matters.

In theology, we Catholics believe that the graces of the Mass will flow out so long as the proper matter (i.e. bread and wine), form (i.e. proper words) and intent (i.e. the intention of the priest to celebrate Mass as the Church intends) are present. However, the capacity to which we benefit from or receive those graces depends on how we individually are disposed, how we have prepared. This is why the Church strongly recommends all the faithful, not just priests and ministers, to take time to prepare for Mass.

This is primarily done through silence and prayer. In the General Instruction, we read the following: "Even before the celebration itself, it is a praiseworthy practice for silence to be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred celebration in a devout and fitting manner." (GIRM 45) There are also several prayers in our catholic tradition referred to as "Prayers for Preparation before Mass," some of which can be found in missalettes, books like The Magnificat, daily Roman Missals, etc. Through these prayers, we reflect and prepare ourselves for the Mass in which we are about to participate.

How we prepare for Mass will directly influence how we receive the Mass. May we all embrace those opportunities of silence and prayer where Our Lord Jesus wishes to meet us!
