



1st Reading Question:



The funding will provide medical and psychological care for the sick, malnourished, and wounded, as well as provide food, shelter, cash assistance, and hygiene supplies for those in need.

Our Holy Father noted with great sorrow that "Gaza is starving."

Together with dioceses across the country and the universal Church, it is imperative that we do what we can to aid our suffering brothers and sisters.


