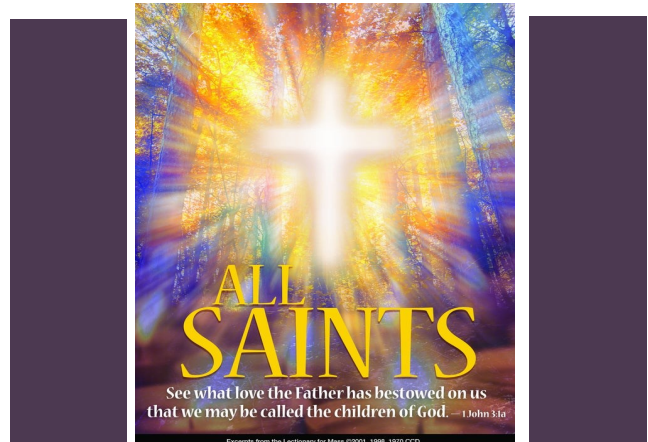
### Solemnity of All Saints

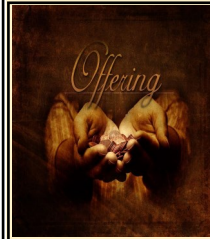

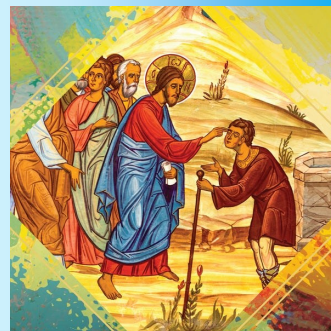
