First Reading — Wisdom is easily discerned by those who love her (Wisdom 6:12-16).

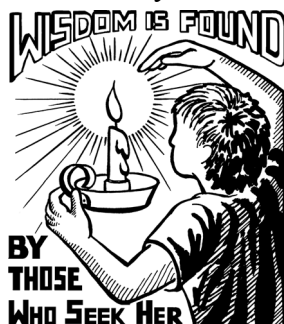
Psalm — My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God (Psalm 63).
