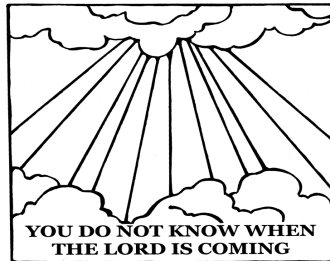
WEEKEND READINGS
