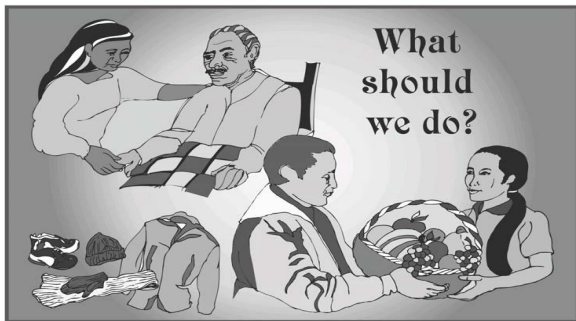
**Second Reading** — Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! (Philippians 4:4-7).
