2. It helps our parish assess how well we are helping you in your spiritual growth.

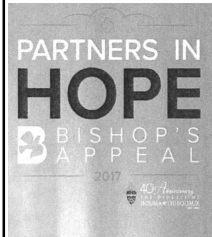

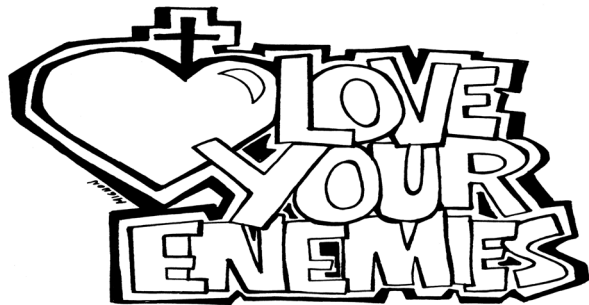
