

First Reading:


During their captivity and exile in Babylon, God assured the Israelites He would restore them into a mighty majestic cedar tree. How do you find comfort in times of despair?

#### A Little Bit of History—Sacred Heart of Jesus, Morgan City

Fr. Thomas Alphonse Smith, pastor of the little wooden Catholic Church near the Atchafalaya River in Morgan City blessed and renamed our parish from St. Clothilde Church to the protection of The Sacred Heart of Jesus on August 15, 1885, on the Feast of the Assumption. In December, 1885, he blessed the "new bell." That bell now hangs in the dome of the Souby Baptistry at Sacred Heart Church. In 1888 the church was blown off its blocks by a terrific storm. It was replaced and secured with hog chains, but was never considered safe afterwards. Then in 1902 the old wooden church was declared, "unfit for divine worship." Pastor at the time, Fr. Andrew Souby would break ground for the new church used by the parishioners of Sacred Heart today. On June 6, 1902, the first spade of dirt was turned by Mr. Dan Lynch. Honor given to him by the pastor because Mr. Lynch managed to place a silver dollar into the collection plate each Sunday when the collection total was only \$2.00, and according to Souby, because he was "a man who passionately loved his church, was never known to miss his mass."

On November 9, 1902 the corner stone was laid and was blessed by Bishop Rouxel. Due to lack of funds the foundation remained untouched for the next two years. - Taken from notes found in the rectory of the History of Morgan City


