

1st Reading Question:



The miracle of the feeding of the 5,000 underscores Jesus' desire to feed us. What do you find yourself hungry for today?




EUCCHARISTIC PROCESSION

### Our New Bishop Elect Fr. Simon Peter Engurait

SIXTH BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF HOUMA THIBODAUX



Born in Ngora, Uganda on August 28, 1971, Father Simon Peter Engurait is one of fourteen children. In 2007, he was accepted as a Seminarian for the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux and entered Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans where he graduated with a Master of Divinity. He was ordained a deacon on May 12, 2012 at St. Bernadette Church in Houma, and on May 25, 2013, he was ordained a priest at the Cathedral of St. Francis de Sales in Houma — both ordinations by Bishop Sam Jacob.

He served as Associate Pastor at the Cathedral of St. Francis de Sales, St. Genevieve Catholic Church in Thibodaux and Christ the Redeemer in Thibodaux. In January of 2017, he was appointed as Administrator and later Pastor of St. Bridget Church in Schriever where he has been to date. He has held multiple diocesan leadership positions including Moderator of the Curia, Coordinator of Christian Formation, and most recently Vicar General. He also served as interim Executive Director of Catholic Charities, and as a member of the Presbyteral Council and College of Consultors .

"While I am still shocked by the news that the Lord has asked me to be a bishop, I must admit that knowing the people of this diocese brings me great comfort in saying yes," said Bishop Elect Engurait. "South Louisiana is home, and I love the people here. It is a privilege to say yes to you as much as I am saying yes to God. I love you, and I consider it a great honor to serve you as your bishop."




## PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION

In addition, the Blessed Virgin is our mother as well (see Revelation 12:17), and her mother's heart is incomparable. St. Louis de Montfort said, "If you put all the love of all the mothers into one heart, it still would not equal the love of the heart of Mary for her children."
