SAINT OF THE WEEK

Ven. Pierre Toussaint

Short Bio —

Venerable Pierre Toussaint was born into slavery but became
an elite hairstylist in New York City and a free man. He used
the money he earned to transform the lives of impoverished
New Yorkers, former slaves, and immigrants alongside his
wife, Servant of God Juliette. He was the very first layman to
be honored by burial in the crypt below
the main altar of St. Patrick's, an honor
usually reserved for bishops of the Archdi-
ocese of New York. He was declared Ven-
erable by Pope John Paul II in 1996.

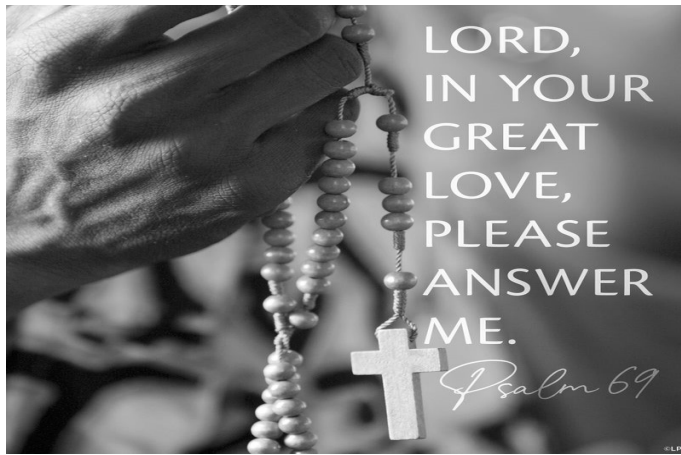

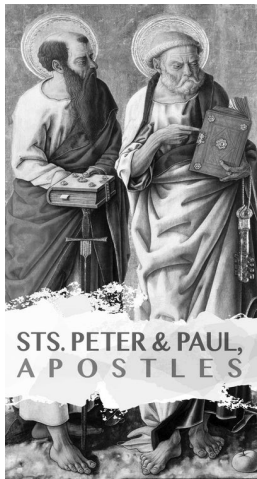
LIVE THE LITURGY— INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

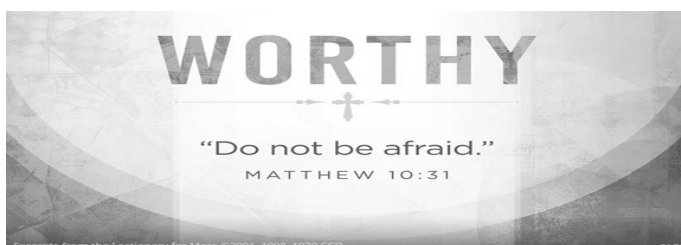
FEAST DAY OF SAINT PETER AND SAINT PAUL

THURSDAY, JUNE 29



Saint Peter one of the twelve and the leader of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church. Saint Paul, who was called to be an apostle, set apart for the Gospel of God and the Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of the Emperor Nero.
