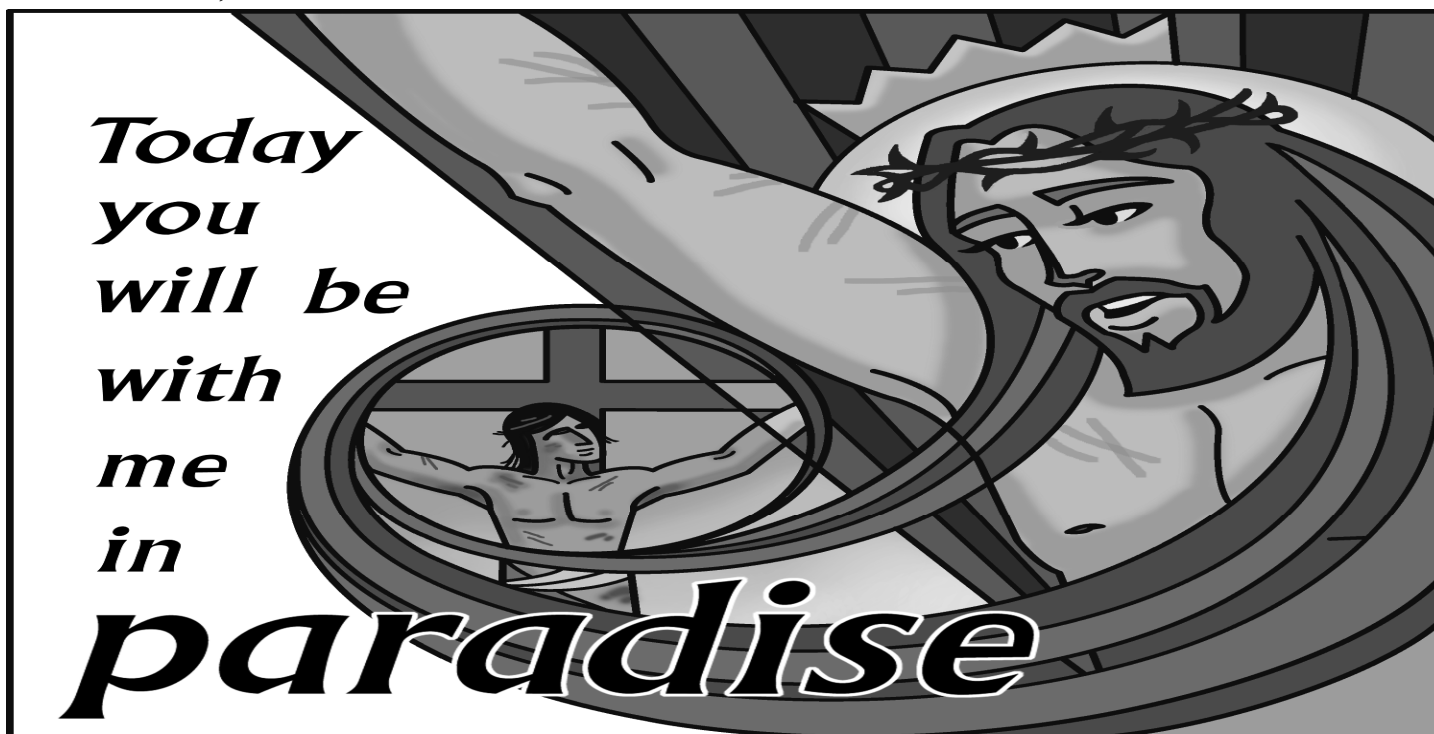

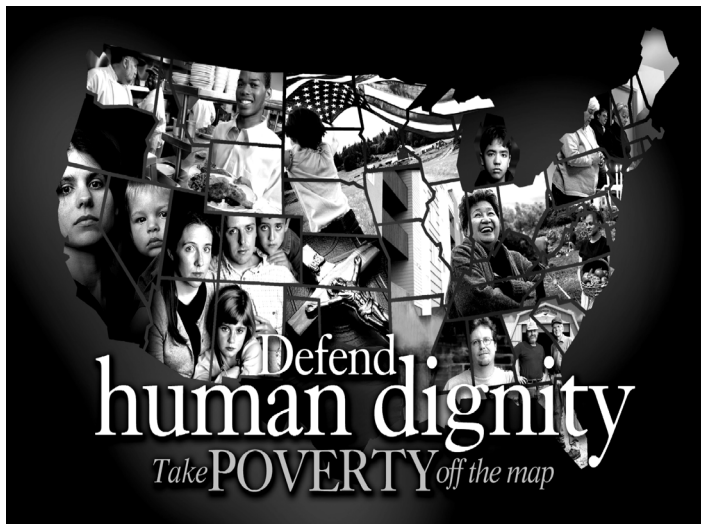

“HELP THE PHILIPPINES WITH IMMEDIATE AID AND TO RECOVER”

Bishop Fabre asked that we take up a special emergency collection for the recovery efforts of Typhoon Haiyan survivors on the weekend of November 30/December 1. This national collection will be to support the humanitarian and institutional needs of the Catholic Church in the Philippines. There is a tremendous need for immediate services—food, water, medicine, shelter, etc , and for long-term recovery. We do have Catholic Relief Services in the area, and they did respond immediately to help the Filipinos in need.

We have many Filipino priests in our diocese who have family members suffering the effects of both the earthquake and the typhoon. These priests have been faithful to us, let us be generous with help for their families and homeland. Make checks payable to Sacred Heart Church. We will send one check in the amount of the total collection to our diocese for distribution. You may also send a check directly to our own Catholic Charities Office, 1220 Aycock St., Houma, La. 70360 with a notation that the donation is for aid to the Philippines.

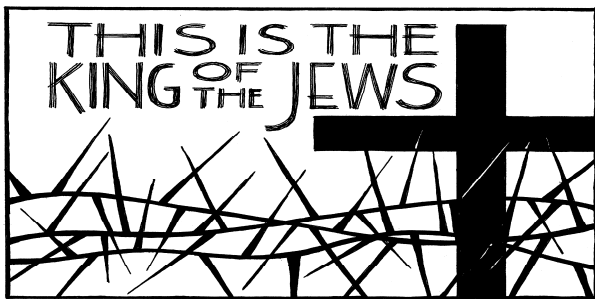
REDEFINING KINGSHIP

This last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year is dedicated to Christ, our King. In the first reading, from the second book of Samuel, we meet Jesus' ancestor David, the greatest king of Israel. This passage describes a glorious monarch who is acclaimed by all the tribes of Israel. He is called both a "shepherd" and a "commander."

The second reading, from Paul's Letter to the Colossians, also contains glorious language, describing Christ as "the firstborn of all creation." Only at the end of this passage do we hear a hint of the paradox we will meet in today's Gospel: Christ the King makes "peace by the blood of his cross."

In Luke's Gospel, we confront the stark reality of Christ's kingship. Here is our king, hanging on a cross, jeered, taunted, berated by a common criminal. This king looks defeated and powerless. Yet he demonstrates how absolute his power is. His death is truly for the salvation of all, one person at a time, starting with the "Good Thief," and continuing through the ages to us today.
