# "Rejoice, Jerusalem!"

Dear Parishioners and Friends.

Adam and Eve are commemorated as saints in the calendars of the Eastern churches—Greeks, Syrians, and Copts. Under the influence of this eastern practice, their veneration spread to the West and became very popular at the beginning of the 11th Century.

In Germany, the custom began in the sixteenth century of putting up a "paradise tree" in the homes to honor our first parents. People in northern Germany would bring little figures of Adam and Eve and the serpent to put under their "Tree of Life." This tree was an evergreen tree laden with apples, and from this practice developed the modern Christmas tree.

In England there is an old Christmas carol that evokes the popularity of the veneration of Adam and Eve on Christmas Eve in the following lyrics:



The Lord at first did Adam make, out of the dust and clay, And in his nostrils breathed life, e'en as the scriptures say. And then in Eden's Paradise, he placed him to dwell, That he within it should remain, to dress and keep it well. Now let good Christians all begin an holy life to live, And to rejoice and merry be, for this is Christmas Eve.

Perhaps this tradition carried over to Morgan City and the choice for one of our church windows. So, I invite you to look at our beautiful and very rare stained glass window of Adam and Eve—the Expulsion from the Garden, and perhaps you can do so with new eyes this Christmas. As we rejoice in the birth of our Savior, let us rejoice in God's mercy as he welcomes us to eat the bread of life and opens for us the gates to Paradise. This ancient processional antiphon for the vigil of Christmas says it better than I can as it states: "Rejoice, Jerusalem! All you lovers of Sion, share our festivities! On this day the age-old bonds of Adam's condemnation were broken, paradise was opened for us, the serpent was crushed, and the woman, who he once deceived, lives now as Mother of the Creator ... Let all creation dance and thrill with joy, for Christ has come to call us home and to save our souls." "Merry Christmas!"
